

2018 International Culture Summer Camp

Volunteer Recruitment Information

1. Purpose

Beigang Township, located in south-western Taiwan and bordering Chiayi County, is one of the three largest population centers in Yunlin County, Taiwan. Beigang Township plays an important role in rural Yunlin County in the following areas: transportation, Taoist beliefs, tourism, cultures, Chinese medical treatments, and education. Beigang Township is also famous for its Beigang Chaotian Temple, one of the most visited temples in Taiwan. However, due to the decrease in working opportunities, more and more young adults have been moving bigger cities to pursue their careers. The population in Beigang Township has been declining year by year.

The International Culture Summer camp will recruit international volunteers and Taiwanese volunteers to assist local children in Beigang Township to learn about different cultures. By introducing different cultures to these mostly rural children, the camp organizers hope to motivate these children to develop more of an interest in foreign languages, as well as to learn to respect various different cultures and broaden their horizons.

Volunteers will also be provided with an in-depth tour of Yunlin County to enjoy the local culture and beauty, and to cultivate a new perspective of mutual trust and mutual assistance.

4. Recruitment Requirements:

College students age 18 to 30 who are enthusiastic and can fully participate in the event (including graduate students, PhD students, international students, and exchange students).

5. Recruitment Methods:

A. Application Process:

B. Volunteer Evaluation and Selection Qualifications:

The selection of volunteers will be conducted through a document review or by phone interview. Qualities sought include language competency, coping capacity, and volunteer experience, etc.

C. Volunteer Recruitments:

International volunteers: 10 will qualify to attend, and 10 will be placed on the waiting list.

Domestic volunteers: 10 will qualify to attend, and 10 will be placed on the waiting list.

※The admission's list will be posted on the website of the Service and Learning Section of National Yunlin University of Science and Technology on March 30th, 2018 (Fri.). After receiving an admission's notification, the volunteers should submit the required documents and NT\$3,000 earnest money before April 10th, 2018 (Tue.). The earnest money will be returned on the last day of the camp. The organization has the authority to cancel the right to participate if the individual does not hand in or is late submitting the documents and the earnest money fee.

※The organizers will notify candidates that are accepted for participation by phone after April 11th, 2018 (Wed.).

※The candidates who are not accepted will not receive any form of notification.

6. Volunteer Obligations:

A. Lecturers will assign volunteers tasks according to their specialties. Volunteers need to assist with activities, even those they are not assigned to, if necessary.

B. Volunteers need to hand in a 1,000-word camp review on the last day of the summer camp.
