IV. Target: New Southbound students (including overseas students) from various fields are welcome to sign up, such as meteorology, electronic technology, environmental science, food supply chain, tourism, law, financial investment, medicine, architecture as well as international affairs, who are interested in agriculture-related industries.

V. Content of activity

- A. 5 series of events are expected to be held, and each visit is planned to be a one-day itinerary, including visits to 2 industry institutions, special lectures on the new southbound direction of agriculture, and group exchanges of opinions. The entire event will be conducted simultaneously in Chinese and English.

B. The entire activity is free. It includes transportation during the visits, lunch, snacks, and insurance during the events. Participants must gather at the designated location on their own according to the session assembly point.

IX. Eligibility and admission principles

- A. Target audience: Students from New Southbound Policy partner countries who are currently studying agriculture and other related majors in various colleges and universities in Taiwan or are interested in the agricultural industry.
- B. Applicant number limit applicants 25 per session.
- C. If the number of applicants for each session exceeds 25, the organizer will sort according to the following criteria to establish the final admission list.

- 1. Number of sessions registered for:** Priority will be given to those who register for a single event. Those who register for multiple events will be sorted according to their registration status.
- 2. Majors:** Priority will be given to students who have majored in agriculture-related fields or have agricultural-related experience or background.
- 3. Participate motivation.** Those who are highly interested or interested in investing in the agricultural field in the future.

X. Participants' study hours and certificates

Full participants will be awarded 6 hours of study hours for each session, and a study certificate will be issued by the Agricultural Technology Research Institute.
