

2026 Tzu Chi University Badminton Tournament

Guideline

1. Purpose: To promote a culture of sports participation, foster cross-cultural friendships between local and international students at Tzu Chi University, and encourage teamwork through athletic exchange. The event also aims to strengthen physical fitness and create a healthy, friendly campus environment in terms of body, mind, and spirit.
2. Supervising Organization: Tzu Chi University
3. Organizing Unit: Office of Global Affairs, Tzu Chi University
4. Date of Competition: May 16, 2026 (Saturday)
5. Venue: Jieren Campus Sport Center
6. Competition Category:
 - (1) Each team must have at least 4 players and no more than 6 players. Each participant may register for only one team.
 - (2) Matches will follow a three-doubles format; the third doubles pair must not repeat players from the first pair.
 - (3) Each team must include at least one international student.
 - (4) No gender restrictions; lineup order is flexible.
 - ★ To encourage international collaboration, teams consisting of members from the same nationality are still eligible to participate. However, if such a team wins, the prize money will be reduced by half.
 - ★ To ensure smooth event operation, registration may close early if the maximum number of participants/teams is reached. Please register as soon as possible. (Announcements will be posted on the Office of Global Affairs Facebook page.)
7. Eligibility:
 - (1) Participants must have completed registration for the 2025-2026 academic

year.

(2) International students must hold a valid ARC and student ID.

(3) Local students must hold a valid student ID.

(4) Students admitted through athletic specialization in badminton or those with national Division A qualification are not eligible.

★ “Athletic-specialized students” refers to those admitted to university based on badminton expertise (via recommendation, special admission, etc.). Students who attended sports-specialized high school programs in badminton or ranked in the top 8 in national high school games.

8. Registration Procedures:

(1) Registration Period: From now until May 8, 2026 (Friday)

(2) Registration Method: Online only

(4) After completing registration, please submit a **NT\$500 deposit** to the Office of Global Affairs at the Zhongyang Campus before the registration deadline (May 8). Teams that check in on time and complete the competition will receive a full refund after the event.

9. Roster Confirmation and Draw:

(1) Roster Confirmation Period: May 11, 2026 (12:00 PM) to May 12, 2026 (12:00 PM)

(2) Rosters will be announced on the Office of Global Affairs Facebook page.

(3) During this period, only corrections of clerical errors are allowed; no player substitutions will be permitted.

(4) If a team withdraws after the confirmation deadline, **the NT\$500 deposit will not be refunded.**

(5) Draw Time: May 13, 2026 (Wednesday) at 2:00 PM

(6) Method: Computer-generated random draw. After the draw, no changes to player rosters will be allowed, and no objections will be accepted. Match schedules will be announced on May 13 at 5:00 PM on the Office of Global Affairs Facebook page.

10. Awards: Top 3 teams will receive prizes and vouchers:

1st Place: **NT\$6,000** voucher + prize

2nd Place: **NT\$4,000** voucher + prize

3rd Place: **NT\$2,000** voucher + prize

11. Insurance: The event is covered by public liability insurance. Participants who require personal accident insurance should arrange it independently. The organizer is not responsible for personal illness or medical compensation arising from accidents.
12. Personal Data & Image Consent: All participants are deemed to have agreed to provide personal data for use in event administration upon registration.
13. Additional Notes: Any matters not covered herein will be announced separately by the organizer. The same applies to any revisions.
