The International Olympic Academy (I.O.A.) has the pleasure to inform you that the 15<sup>th</sup> International Seminar on Olympic Studies for Postgraduate Students will be held in Ancient Olympia from the 5<sup>th</sup> July 2007 (arrival in Athens) to 8<sup>th</sup> August 2007 (departure from Athens).

The Post-Graduate Seminar Is a forum for studies on the "three pillars" – the Olympic Games, the Olympic Movement and Olympism. These studies involve both the Ancient Games and contemporary Olympic issues. The special subject of the 15<sup>th</sup> International Post-Graduate Seminar is "From Athens to Beijing".

Soon entering its fifteenth year, the Post-Graduate Seminar has proved a unique catalyst in the domain of Olympic studies. Professors from all over the world, specialised in Olympic Movement issues contribute to the works of the Seminar.

The Seminar is divided into four periods or cycles:

- a) The Ancient Olympic Games and their philosophy.
- b) The modern Olympic Movement, the revival of the Olympic Games and Olympic Education.
- c) The socio-political and economic aspects of the modern Olympic Games (business, media and communication, management and organisation).
- d) The ethical and philosophical issues as well as the athletes' rights in the modern Olympic Movement



In this respect, we would really appreciate it, if you could recommend to the I.O.A. one candidate student the soonest possible, and in any case, not later than 15th April 2007. Only thirty five (35) to forty (40) students from all over the world will be selected by the Ephoria of the I.O.A. for the 15th Postgraduate Seminar. Candidates should be up to 40 years of age.

For all these reasons, we need to have the student's detailed <u>Curriculum Vitae</u>, the topic of the paper, a list with the titles of any publications, a two-page summary of the paper, a recommendation letter by his/her Supervising Professor, as well as two passport-size photos, by 15th April 2007 at the latest. The final decision will be announced to the selected students around the end of April 2007.

Accommodation and boarding expenses for the selected students, both in Athens – upon arrival and departure – and in Olympia – throughout their stay there – will be covered by the I.O.A. Travelling expenses, however, should be covered by the students themselves.

English will be the sole working language of the Seminar. It is, therefore, essential that all Participants have a perfect grasp of both spoken and written English.

Candidates must be post-graduate students, from all scientific fields, involved in scientific research on Olympic and sports issues. Please, do your best as far as the selection of the candidate is concerned. The candidate should possess the necessary scientific and academic qualifications to present a scientific paper — no more than eight (8) pages long — related to the Olympic Movement which will be incorporated in a special report to be published by the I.O.A. It is recommended that the student have completed his/her paper by 31st May 2007.

Students will have fifteen (15) minutes during the evening sessions (17.00 p.m. - 18.30 p.m.) at their disposal to present their papers.
