GOAL

All full papers presented at the conference will be considered for possible publication in the International Journal of Cyber Society and Education (IJCSE), a referred and series publication of e-CASE & e-Tech conference with ISSN. Competitive papers will be recommended for fast-track reviews to the International Journal of Business and Information (IJBI) that agrees to publish a special issue.
